The City of Bradenton City Council met in the City Hall Council Chamber, 101 Old Main Street, Bradenton, Florida, at 5:01 p.m. on Thursday, September 17, 2020.

Present: Mayor Wayne Poston; Councilman Ward I Gene Gallo; Councilwoman Ward II Marianne Barnebey; Councilman Ward III Patrick Roff; Councilman Ward IV Bill Sanders; and Vice Mayor/Councilman Ward V Harold Byrd, Jr.

City Officials: Carl Callahan, City Administrator; Sharon Beauchamp, City Clerk & Treasurer; Charles Edwards, Fire Chief; Melanie Bevan, Police Chief; Jim McLellan, Public Works & Utilities Director; and Scott Rudacille, City Attorney.

Mayor Wayne Poston opened the meeting at 5:01 p.m. and turned it over to **Carl Callahan, City Administrator**. Mr. Callahan thanked Council for allowing the meeting to be held on a Thursday as opposed to a Wednesday.

Sharon Beauchamp, City Clerk & Treasurer announced the City Clerk's Office did not receive any citizen comments via voicemail or email prior to the meeting.

Ms. Beauchamp officially read in to the record:

- The name of the taxing authority: City of Bradenton
- The rolled-back rate: 5.6834
- The percent increase over the rolled back rate: 3.77%
- The millage rate to be levied: 5.8976

RESOLUTION 20-69 – MILLAGE RATE – SECOND READING AND PUBLIC HEARING

A RESOLUTION LEVYING TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2020 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021, AND PROVIDING FOR THE DISBURSEMENT OF FUNDS ARISING FROM SAID LEVY; ALSO THE DISBURSEMENTS OF CERTAIN OTHER FUNDS.

RESOLUTION 20-70– BUDGET – SECOND READING AND PUBLIC HEARING

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE BUDGET; AND SETTING REVENUES AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-21; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Public Hearing was opened. Those in favor were asked to come forward.

Keenan Wooten, 1915 11th Avenue East announced he would prefer the millage rate not increase for the 2020-2021 budget year.

Those opposed were invited to come forward. None came.
The Public Hearing was closed.

MOTION TO APPROVE RESOLUTION 20-70 ADOPTING THE CITY OF BRADENTON BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 was made by Councilman Roff and seconded by Councilman Byrd. Motion passed 5-0.

Mr. Callahan thanked Council for approving the 2020-2021 millage rate and budget.
