## Ordinance 3072 – SECOND READING AND PUBLIC HEARING

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, AMENDING PART 1, CHARTER AND RELATED LAWS, SUBPART B, RELATED LAWS, ARTICLE IV, POLICE OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA; AMENDING SECTION 1, DEFINITIONS; AMENDING SECTION 2, MEMBERSHIP; AMENDING SECTION 7, PRE-RETIREMENT DEATH; AMENDING SECTION 8, DISABILITY; AMENDING SECTION 9, VESTING; AMENDING SECTION 19, DOMESTIC RELATIONS ORDERS, RETIREE DIRECTED PAYMENTS, EXEMPTION FROM EXECUTION; AMENDING SECTION 27, MILITARY SERVICE PRIOR TO EMPLOYMENT; AMENDING SECTION 28, PRIOR POLICE SERVICE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY OF PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

## ORDINANCE NUMBER 3074 – FIRST READING

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BRADENTON, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE OFFERING FOR HIRE OF MOTORIZED SCOOTERS OR MICROMOBILITY DEVICES, OR ISSUANCE OF ANY AUTHORIZATIONS, PERMITS OR FRANCHISES PERTAINING TO MICROBILITY, ADOPTED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 3055 AND EXTENDED PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 3062; AND PROVIDING THAT SAID MORATORIUM SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL MAY 9, 2021, OR SHALL TERMINATE ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE CITY'S ADOPTION OF AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOTORIZED SCOOTERS OR MICROMOBILITY DEVICES.
