



ITEMS TO RECYCLE



CANS



Aluminum and Steel Cans
Empty and rinse.



CARTONS



Food and Beverage Cartons
Empty, rinse and replace cap.



GLASS



Bottles and Jars
Empty, rinse and replace cap.



PAPER



Mixed Paper
Flatten cardboard and boxes.



PLASTICS



Plastic Bottles and containers
Empty, rinse and replace cap.

WHEN IN DOUBT, LEAVE IT OUT!



NO Recyclables in Plastic Bags
Empty loose recyclables in carts.



NO Food and Liquids
Compost if possible, or throw in trash.



NO Diapers
Throw in trash.



NO Plastic Bags
Return to retail.



NO Styrofoam
Including packing peanuts or Styrofoam.



NO Hazardous Waste
Take to the county's chemical collection center.

Do Not Put: wet cardboard, pots and pans, fencing material or car auto parts

Follow the 3 feet rule!

Keep carts at least 3 feet away from other carts, mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars and utility poles so trucks can easily access cart.



Point this arrow toward the street.
